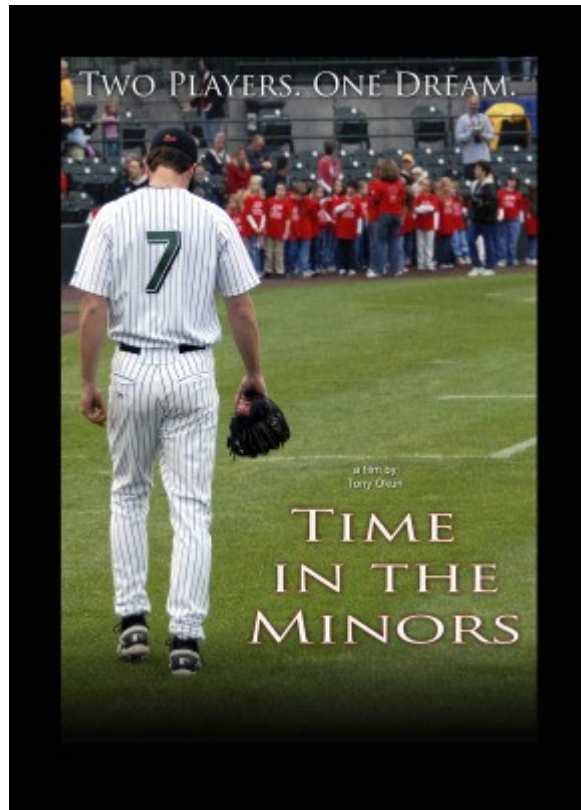
\$1,000 for team equipment
